I have a first-class degree in maths from Cambridge University, a Post Graduate Certificate of Education from the University of Wales, Bangor, and an MSc in Mathematics from Warwick University. I also have a PhD from University of Southampton. My thesis was on the assessment of A level Maths, in particular the role of context in A level maths questions.

My teaching career was at Manchester Grammar School, Aylesbury Grammar School, St Birinus School Didcot and St Vincent College, Gosport, the latter three as head of maths.

I have also worked curriculum development, as Executive Director of the School Mathematics Project for 7 years. I spent a year as a Lecturer in Maths Education at the London Institute of Education.

I have been a Principal Examiner in A level Maths and Further Maths for over 25 years. I have been a consultant for the Cambridge Assessment Centre, and an Open University tutor.

I have written numerous articles for Maths Education Journals and the Times Educational Supplement and authored and edited curriculum materials in mathematics.
